The story of Socrates and the three sieves

One day a man runs up to Socrates and said: “I have to tell you something about your friend who...”
“Hold up” Socrates interrupts him “About the story you’re about to tell me, did you put it trough the three sieves?”
The man was not familiar with the three sieves, so Socrates continued: “The first is the sieve of Truth. Are you sure that what you are going to tell me is true?”
“To tell the truth”, said the man, “no, I just overheard it”.
“What about the sieve of Goodness. Will you tell me something good or positive about this man?”
The man shook his head.
“Now, what about the last sieve. Is it necessary to tell me what you’re so excited about?”
When the man bowed his head in shame, Socrates smiled and said “Well, if the story you’re about to tell me is neither true, good or necessary, just forget it and don’t bother me with it.”
The story about the three sieves is something we can apply to our lives. Before you tell a story or pass on a rumour, ask yourself whether it is true, kind or necessary. Often we pass on gossip we’ve heard to keep the conversation going or talk negatively about somebody we know. Why not focus on “uptalking” others, concentrating on their strengths?

Learning About Love



On July 26, we celebrate St. Anne and St. Joachim, the grandparents of Jesus. I recently learned that devotion to them is experiencing a resurgence of interest among young people. When asked why, one priest replied, “A grandmother never says no.” If you read **Priez la Parole** regularly, you know that my grandmother holds a special place in my heart, and I don’t think I’m the only one who feels that way. We often have more peaceful relationships with our grandparents than with our parents. This, it seems to me, is linked to the fact that a long life—sometimes fraught with challenges, like that of the Virgin Mary’s parents—deepens the unconditional nature of love. After a certain age, all that remains is love. My grandmother loves me just as I am.

As a teenager, I was deeply moved by a similar line (taken straight from a crime drama): “God loves me just as I am.” That phrase and my grandmother’s unconditional love helped me better understand God’s love for us, to keep praying while trying to put that love into practice, even when the noise of the world was nothing but a cacophony of judgments and condemnations. It has also guided my reading of the Bible and allowed me to accept certain more disturbing passages, such as the story of the sacrifice of Isaac. I am convinced that God does not want us to sacrifice our children to Him—especially not because we believe we must do so because He supposedly asked us to. To us, His ways are inscrutable, but He is never surprised by His creation, and He loves it. So, when in doubt, let’s follow in our grandparents’ footsteps and love without reservation.

My grandmother prays a lot, too. And I’m convinced that it has also taught her to love more deeply, more and more unconditionally. After all, what better teacher in this area than Love itself? But it’s true that, like any learning process, it takes time...

That’s perfect timing! It’s summer—vacation time, a time for love. To paraphrase a great writer, the time we spend praying, like the time we spend loving, expands the time we have to live. This lesson in love gives you the feeling of living longer—but above all, happier. Ask God to walk with you. He, too—as you no doubt already know—never says no.
