
Coat of Arms

The miter is decorated with a Golden Cross adorned with five red stones representing the Five Wounds of Our Lord Jesus Christ, symbol of salvation.

The white expresses the joy of the resurrection.

In the top left, a rose of Gules, with five green tips, button in the center, symbol of transparency, justice and truth, expressing British ancestry.

At the bottom left, the Feather symbolises the Aboriginal peoples.

At the bottom right, the Bible, on a golden background, symbol of divinity.

The banner at the bottom with the words of our Lord Jesus Christ: UT UNUM SINT, “That they may be one” (Jn 17).
